VINTAGE WICKER FURNITURE—frequently petite—often looks lost in today's expansive beach houses, said interior designer Michael Cox of Foley & Cox, a New York firm that specializes in seaside retreats. And "if it's 50-plus years old," he added, "the wicker or caning can start looking a little tatty." So frustrated were Mr. Cox and his partner, Mary Foley, by the dearth of suitably scaled pieces at auction that they designed their own more strapping solution: the new Cabo Chaise, a fluid Bauhaus-inspired divan that's 60 inches long and 27 inches wide and was a crowd pleaser at last month's Architectural Digest Home Show in New York. Standing in for wicker is polypropylene, a tough, outdoor-friendly material that looks on tempests and is never shaken, as that great beach-house authority, William Shakespeare, once said.
